Know all men by these presents that wee John: Fraunlin of Somerset County wife intermarried to Rhodia: Fraunlin
Countess of the last will and Testament of John: Copper etc and Samuel: Hopkin and James: Sangster of
the same County Gent^m are holden and firmly bounden unto the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^r in the just quantity
of fourly eight thousand two hundred ninety eight pound of lb to be pd to the sd Lord Prop^r his Heirs
Successors or Assigns, to whose payment well and truly to be mad. and done, we bind our selves, our Heirs, Exors
and adors Joyntly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 20th day of Dec^r
1690.

The Condition of the above sd Obligation is such that if the above bounden John: Fraunlin shall well and truly
administer all and singular the goods chattels and Credits of John: Copper late of the said County deceased according to
the Will of the same in granted, and shall well and truly satisfy and pay or cause to be well and truly satisfied and paid
the debt of the said deceased so far forth as the Estate of the said deceased will extend, and also a true & just
Inventory of the Estate of the said deceased shall exhibit within lawfully called, and shall in all things well and
truly behave and demean himself in the said Executorship, then this Obligation to be void and of no effect
else to be in force and virtue.

to ask, levy, demand, receive and receive, any and all debts due or owing unto me from any person within the
said County of Somerset howsoever due unto me in lawfull manner, and what soever is owing to me by any person or
persons as aforesaid, whether it be money, tobacco, goods, Merchandize or any other thing or things whatsoever
giving and by these presents granting unto my said attorney, my full power and lawfull authority, in and about
premisses for the full and effectual obtaining of any and all debts due to me as aforesaid, and upon receipt thereof
or of any part thereof, or quitclaimed or otherwise sufficient release or discharge in my name to make seal and
deliver, and other attorney or attorneys under him to constitute my power and authority, and them at his pleasure
again to receive, and finally to do say conclude and finish any further act or acts, thing or things, debts
or debts in the law or otherwise for the recovering of my said debts, and what soever my said attorney shall
do or cause to be done in and about the premisses according to law. Gods by these presents, obliging my self
to ratify and confirm the same. As witness my hand and seal this 25th day of March in the 10th year of the
dominion of the Right Hon^{ble} Charles 2^d King of Great Brittain 1685.
