Court of Requests.

A Court held by their Honors Justices of the Peace for the County of Somerset the
 eleventh day of September Anno Domini 1690
 M^r. *James* Coll. *David Brown*. M^r. *Franklin*. *John*. M^r. *James*. *Rownd*. M^r. *Samuel*
 in Court were *Hopkins*. M^r. *Thomas*. *John*. *Cap*. *John*. *King*.

John Franklin in Open Court confessed judgment for three hundred and ten pounds
 of labour due to the Estate of *M^r. Archibald*. *Archibald*. *Cap*. *David Brown* due to
 the said *Archibald*.

Memorandum that *John Franklin* who intermarried *Rhodia* *Franklin* to the Estate of
John Cooper died, this day, put up a writing at the Court door, intimating a plea to the writ
 in order to a Quodlibet.

Pettie Juries dismissed.

Ordered That all persons hereafter that do not bring in to Court their Charges at the
 last by Lymey. shall next year at the last by Lymey appear and shew Cause why
 they did not bring in their County charges as aforesaid.

Whereas their Honors Justices of the Peace for this County have received divers affronts and injuries
 at *M^r. Andrew* *Whitniglow* house, in their public Court rooms, by unworthy dissatisfied persons. It
 is therefore ORDERED, that during the time of Court days, no person whatsoever, shall attempt, or be
 admitted into the said Room where the Justices are, without leave or ORDER from some of their worships
 the room appointed for the Justices, is that above the Court.

This day the County Levy was laid which did amount to 37^l. 4^s. 6^d. County Levy 51^l. 10^s. 6^d.

Blom at *Cap^t. Culbert* 20 guns wanting 2 new slots & 2 would mending. 6 straw pins, 1 Cort & Cort pin, 1 let, 1 up
Blom. *Esq^r. Layfield*. 6. guns wanting one upper Jaw, one Cort pin one slot.
Blom 10: guns at the sea side wanting one new slot, one main spring. 2 slots, 2 Cort pins, 2 upper Jaws
 two straw pins and one ferril. — — this above was given in by *Joseph Donald*.

Ordered That all these persons that had any of the County Drums in this County be summoned to
 the next Court to render account thereof.
