Seized both the Limaway and Boat according to Law, but fraudulently and craftily intending to frustrate the said Court, together with one John: Clerk of this County Court, did both conceal the Servant and Boat from the knowledge of any Magistrate or Officer whereby the said Servant and Boat might have been returned for the right owner being flat contrary to the laws and institutions of this Province - enjoying and authorizing all persons to take up all such suspicious persons coming into this Province without a pass, and also act the ditto in prohibiting all persons to entertain or deal and trade with any such person or servant without the Magistrate's knowledge. Therefore the said Attorney General may be ordered against the said John: Clerk according to Law in that case made and provided - or.

Indictment being read, the said John: Clerk in open Court confessed to the Boat as aforesaid and there is ordered by the Court to deliver the said Boat into the custody of the Sheriff. By him to be returned till the owner come. Likewise the said John: Clerk is ordered to give good security for his good behavior and appearance every Court during pleasure. Whereupon found the said John: Clerk and by Estrogizant did acknowledge himself to be indebted to their Majesties in the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money, and also his two children in Debt to their Majesties in the sum of ten pounds of like money to be levied on their goods and Chattels lands and tenements.

Condition of white Estrogizant is such that if the above said John: Clerk do be of the good behavior and appearance to all their Majesties Liege people of this Province, and also make his personal appearance every Court before our said Justices, during pleasure, and also deliver the above mentioned Boat as well also to pay all Court charges, that then the said Estrogizant shall be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full power force and virtue.

Laron Bishop being summoned to show cause why he did not attend on the Grand Jury in November last being then legally summoned and now being called to show reason why he did not then appear, made no appearance and therefore was ordered to be fined according to rules of Court.

The Court adjourns till tomorrow at 9 o'clock
