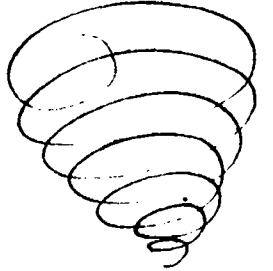

Declaration being read, this Court has ordered speciall bail, or the bail
Bond to be assigned to the pl.

Their Majesties Somerset County ss. John Carey of this County Plaintiff was
summoned to answer their Majesties in a plea of debt, and was
upon their Majesties attorney's command and says that the deft. John
Carey is and stands indebted unto their Majesties in the full and just
sum of twenty pounds sterling money as appears by a recognizance
entered and engrossed the 11th day of March du. 1689. upon record at a County Court holden the day
and year aforesaid. the condition of the said recognizance being such that if the said Carey deft should well
and truly keep their Majesties estate, and be of the good behaviour and observing to all their Majesties good people
of this County, then the said recognizance to be void pro. But so it is that the said deft like regarding the
said recognizance, the condition thereof hath broken, and upon the 11th day of November last past at the
house of Andrew Wittmeyer Gunholder, was put into custody for swearing, drunkenness till he was
drunk, and fighting before their Majesties Justice of the Peace in Court sitting adjudged guilty where by
the said recognizance of twenty pounds sterling money became forfeit to their Majesties. Therefore their
Judgment may be entered against the said Carey as in Law is provided. J. Sawyer.

Declaration being read the Court demanded of the said Carey, if he had any reason to show why
Judgment should not be entered against him, according to Law. and the said Carey made
small defence for him self totally referring him self to the favour of the Court, humbly
requesting his evidents might be examined, where to the said Carey was granted.

Evidents examined were Robert Down and Wm. Carey for the deft. who both affirmed that they
saw John Compton and William Compton strike the said Carey, likewise Wm. Haust struck the said
Wm. Carey saith he saw Jn. Compton strike the said Carey first in the face before witness made, then
the said Carey threw the said Jn. down. then the said William Compton came saying ill and the quarrel struck
the said Carey: all which being considered by the Court, It is ordered that the said Carey pay the
principal debt viz twenty pounds sterling money, with Cost of Suit -
Wm. Haust: Gouther and Cap. John Under do not assent to the aforesaid judgment of Court.
