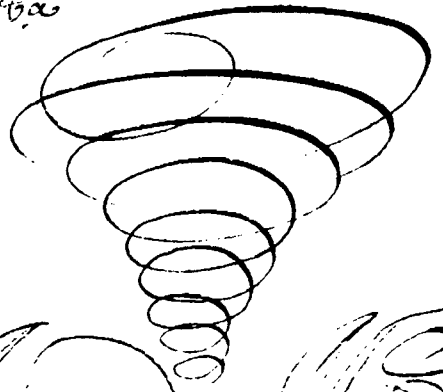
John: Gosney and Manasse: Merriis bound in 10 lb man for Robert: Good that he should stand tryall and abide judgement vice proceedings folio 87.
