3. **BE IT ENACTED**, That Daniel Lammot, Emanuel Kent, Ebenezer Finley, George Warner, Luke Tiernan, Adam Welsh and Lewis Pascault, be and they are hereby constituted commissioners(a) of the said market, until the first Monday in February, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen; and that they have, use and exercise, all the powers and authority vested in such commissioners, as well by the aforesaid original act and the supplement thereto, to which this is an additional supplement, as by an act of the general assembly\*, entitled, "An act to appoint commissioners to grade and level the several streets, squares, lanes and alleys, in the precincts of Baltimore. 6. **BE IT ENACTED**, That so much of the several acts to which this is an additional supplement, as is contrary to, or inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed. Acts contrary to

CHAP. XIX.

*An Act to authorise the drawing of a Lottery or Lotteries in Middletown, in Frederick County.* Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 40. Passed Dec 27.

1. **BE IT ENACTED**, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Frederick Stemble, senior, Thomas Powel, Adam Routsawn, junior, Jacob Herring, Nicholas Bowlus, Conrad Young, (of Jacob,) and Christian Kogle, or such of them as shall enter into bond as herein after required, be and they are hereby authorised to raise by lottery or lotteries, at any place within this state, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars, and sell and dispose of the tickets at any place within the same, free from any tax. Managers autho-  
rised to dispose of  
tickets free of tax.

2. **AND BE IT ENACTED**, That before any of the persons above named shall proceed to make sale of any ticket or tickets, they shall give bond in double the sum to be raised by said lottery or lotteries, conditioned that they will well and truly apply so much of the money arising therefrom, within six months after the drawing thereof, as shall satisfy the fortunate adventurers for prizes drawn by them, and after deducting the necessary expenses, within two years thereafter apply the residue for the purpose of building a steeple to the new church now erecting in said town, and also for the purchasing of bells to put in the same. To give bond.

3. **AND BE IT ENACTED**, That the bond so as aforesaid to be entered into, be lodged with the clerk of Frederick county court, and upon the same, or any office copy thereof, suit or suits may be brought for any breach or noncompliance with the conditions thereof. Bond to be lodged  
in clerk's office.
