CHAP. CXXXVIII.

An Act relating to the Governor and Council of this State. Lib. TH. Passed Dec 23. No. 3, fol. 476.

WHEREAS by an act, entitled, An act to alter the time of the meeting of the general assembly of this state, and for other purposes, passed at November session eighteen hundred and eleven, it is provided, that the governor and council shall be elected in the month of December, instead of the month of November as heretofore: And whereas, doubts are entertained whether a suspension of executive powers will not thereby occur; for remedy whereof, Preamble. + Ch. 221.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the present governor and council of this state, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to act in their executive capacity until the times severally prescribed for the next election of a governor and council by the above recited act. Present executive authorised to act.

CHAP. CXXXIX.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to grant a public Road and confirm the same in the upper part of Queen-Anne's County. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 477. Passed Dec 21 1804, ch. 62.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly by the petition of sundry inhabitants of Queen Anne's county, that by the act to which this is a supplement, passed at November session eighteen hundred and four, the commissioners therein appointed to view, examine, inspect and return, a plot of the road therein mentioned, have not performed the duties therein required, because a part of said road had been changed and another part of said road had been shut up; therefore, Preamble. Ch. 62.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners appointed or to be appointed by the act to which this is a supplement, be and they are hereby authorised and directed to view, examine, and return a plot of the aforesaid road, as it now runs, from the gate of Richard Tilghman, (the 4th,) near the Manor road, until it intersects the road leading from J. B. to Dixon's tavern, and to cause that part of said road heretofore laid out between the lands of Joseph M. Conekin and Samuel Chapley, to be opened and cleared, and shall return a plot of the whole of the aforesaid road to the clerk of Queen Anne's county, to be there recorded, and the said road shall be deemed and taken to be a public road, and shall be kept in repair as other public roads in said county. Commissioners appointed to examine and return a plot of road.

CHAP. CXL.

A Supplement to the act(a), entitled, An act to incorporate a Company for erecting a Bridge over Great Choptank River, at or near Dover Ferry. Lib TH. No. 3, fol. 477. Passed Dec. 23. (a) 1810, ch. 112. Sec 1815, ch. 122.

WHEREAS by an act of assembly passed at November session eighteen hundred and ten, a company was incorporated to build a Preamble.
