AND BE IT ENACTED, That until there shall be, under this act, an election of officers necessary to the ends of this institution. those now acting, or who may be hereafter appointed to act, under any existing regulations of the society, shall continue so to do, according to the provisions heretofore made. and such regulations shall, till lawfully altered, be deemed as valid and obligatory as if made since the passing of this act.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Anne Arundel county be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at their annual meeting, so long as they shall see cause so to do, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, towards the support and maintenance of the said John Carman, his wife and their three children, which said sum of money, when collected, shall be annually paid over by the collector of Anne-Arundel county to the said John Carman, or to his order.
