CHAP. II.

*An Act to authorise and empower the Levy Court of Anne-Arundel County to assess and levy a sum of money for the support and maintenance of Rebecca Lee, and her eight Children.* Lib. TH. No. 4, fol. 51. Passed Jan 10, 1814

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Anne-Arundel county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at their annual meeting, so long as they shall see cause so to do, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, towards the support and maintenance of the said Rebecca Lee, and her eight children, which said sum of money, when collected, shall be annually paid over by the collector of Anne-Arundel county to the said Rebecca Lee, or to her order. Levy authorised for her support.

CHAP. LII.

*An Act for the relief of Valinda Wommen Conaway, of the City of Annapolis.* Lib. TH. No. 4, fol. 52. Passed Jan 10, 1814

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Anne-Arundel county, shall be and they are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy court annually, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of Valinda Wommen Conaway, and that the same be collected annually by the collector of Anne-Arundel county, and paid the said Valinda Wommen Conaway, or to her order. Levy authorised for her support.
