Mulliken, their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic by the name and style of The Franklin Manufacturing Company of Maryland, and by that name may have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, in any court of law or equity, and to make and use a common seal, and the same to change and alter at their pleasure, and to ordain and establish such by-laws and regulations as shall be necessary or convenient
