CHAP. 19.

*An Act to release the right of the State to a part of a Tract of Land therein mentioned.* Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 158. A Private Act.

Passed Dec 17

The state's right to a part of a tract of land called *Jum Hoyle*, in Montgomery county, relinquished to and vested in the heirs of Martin Fisher.

CHAP. XX.

*An Act to provide for completing the unfinished Records of the Orphans Court of Frederick County.* Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 159. Passed Dec 17

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the register of wills for Frederick county, shall be paid by the levy court of said county, out of the county rates thereof, to be levied for that purpose, the usual fees provided by law, when he shall bring up and complete the unfinished records of the orphans court of said county, from the first of January, 1811, to the appointment and qualification of Henry Steiner, the present register of wills of said county. CHAP. XXI.

*A Supplement to the act\*, entitled, An act to Incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike Road from the Town of Westminster, in Frederick County, through Harman's Gap, to Hager's-Town, in Washington County.* Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 159. Passed Dec 17

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the election for president, managers and treasurer, of said company, be hereafter held on the second Monday of October next, and on the same day in every year thereafter, instead of the first Monday directed by the act to which this is a supplement. Time changed for election of officers

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the grade of said road across the mountains may, in the discretion of the president and managers of said company, be increased, where necessary, to an elevation that in no case shall exceed an angle of five degrees with an horizontal line, any provisions in the original act to which this is a supplement to the contrary notwithstanding. Company may increase grade of road

3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the president, managers and treasurer, of said company, elected for the present year, shall hold their several appointments until the next election of officers shall take place in virtue of this act. Present officers to continue until a new election

CHAP. XXII.

*An Act for the Revaluation of Real and Personal Property in Anne-Arundel, Talbot, and Somerset Counties.* Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 160. Passed Dec 17

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of the tax for Anne-Arundel, Talbot, and Somerset counties, be and they are hereby authorised and directed, to meet at their respective county towns, immediately after the passage of this act, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, and proceed, agreeably to the provisions of an act passed November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled, An act for the valuation of real and personal property in the several counties of this state, to revalue and reassess the real and personal property within said counties.
