CHAP. XLVII.

An Act to confirm the Title of James Alexander and John Alexander, of Harford County, to certain Lands therein mentioned(a). Passed Jan 6, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 182. A Private Act.**

(a) Conveyed to them by Jabez Kirkwood, and Mary his wife, Thomas Barnett and Isabel his wife, and Isabel Alexander.

CHAP. XLVIII.

An Act for the support of James Ridgeway, of Caroline County. Passed Jan 4, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 183.**

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Caroline county be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to assess and levy annually, on the assessable property of said county, so long as they shall see fit so to do, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of James Ridgeway of said county, to be collected as other county charges are, and by the collector paid over to the said James Ridgeway, or his order. Levy authorised for his support.

CHAP. XLIX.

An Act to confirm the Title of John Williams, of Cecil County, to certain Lands therein mentioned(b). Passed Jan 7, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 183. A Private Act.**

(b) Conveyed to him by Thomas and Charles Greer, to whom they had been conveyed by William M. Grath.

CHAP. L.

An Act to appoint Isaac Mayo, of the City of Annapolis, Trustee for the sale of certain Real Estate therein mentioned(c). Passed Jan 9, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 184. A Private Act.**

(c) In which Jonathan Waters, and Sarah Ann his wife, hold a life estate, with remainder in fee tail to their son Thomas Gassaway Waters, a minor.

CHAP. LI.

An Act to confirm the Title of Hugh Quigley and John M. Greagor, of Harford County, to certain Lands therein mentioned(d). Passed Jan 7, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 187. A Private Act.**

(d) Conveyed by John Neel and Jehu Thomas to Hugh Quigley, and by William Jones to John M. Greagor. See a supplement, 1818, ch. 63, confirming a deed from William Jones to James M. Greagor.

CHAP. LII.

An Act to authorise Edward Brown, late Sheriff and Collector of Kent County, to complete his Collections. Passed Jan 9, 1817. **Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 188.**
