1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Lottery authorised Samuel Hanson, senior, William Vincent, Thomas A. Davis, John Matthews, Samuel Chapman and John Weems, are hereby appointed managers, and they, or a majority of them, are authorised to raise by way of lottery or lotteries, a sum of money not exceeding twenty thousand dollars over and above all expenses and commissions on the sales of fickets, for the purpose of paying the expenses already incurred in erecting a church in Port Tobacco Parish, in Charles county, and such further expenses as may be necessary to finish the said church in a manner suitable for a place of public worship.
