

CHAP. 131. and on the first Monday in May in every year, or within two days thereafter, for such purpose, and at such place as the president and managers shall appoint; and in all elections by stockholders each share shall be entitled to one vote; *Provided always*, that no person shall have more than twenty-five votes.

Proviso

Stockholders incorporated.

4. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the stockholders in said company shall be and they are hereby created and erected into a body corporate, by the name and style of The Hager's-Town and Conococheague Turnpike Company, and by the same name shall have perpetual succession, and all the privileges and franchises incident to a corporation, and shall be capable of suing and being sued, answering and being answered, and of enlarging their stock by new subscriptions if the same shall be found necessary.

Subscriptions, how to be paid.

5. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the sums so subscribed shall be paid to the president and managers of the company in such sums, and at such times, as they may appoint, giving two months public notice of the payment required.

Commissioners to be appointed to lay out road.

6. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the president and managers be, and they are hereby authorised, to appoint three commissioners, who, or a majority of whom agreeing, shall lay out the said road in the nearest and best direction, from the market space in Hager's-Town, to intersect the Cumberland turnpike road on the west bank of the Conococheague creek, and after having laid out and marked said road, shall make out a plot of the same, specifying the course and distance, and return the said plot to the president and managers; and said commissioners, before they proceed to act, shall take the following oath or affirmation: "I, A. B. do swear or affirm, that I will lay out and mark the Hager's-Town and Conococheague turnpike road according to the best of my skill and judgment, agreeably to the direction of this act; and I do further swear, or affirm, that I am not interested in any land through which the said road is likely to pass."

Width of road.

7. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the said company shall open said road from Hager's-Town, according to the location of the commissioners aforesaid, sixty feet wide, of which at least twenty feet shall be an artificial road, composed of stone or gravel, and erect and keep up bridges over streams crossing the same; and when the said road and bridges shall be perfect, said company shall be entitled to receive toll for one full gate; *Provided*, that no toll be demanded or taken from any person passing or repassing to or from any public worship or funeral, on days appointed for that purpose, or from militia-men on days of training, or from voters on days of election, attending the polls, going to, and returning from, the same.

Powers and privileges of company.

8. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That said company shall be and are hereby invested and clothed with all the privileges, rights, immunities and advantages, which are held and possessed by the turnpike company incorporated by an act passed at November session, eighteen hundred and twelve*, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the District of Columbia to the city of Baltimore, and also with all the rights, privileges and immunities, which are held and possessed by the Cumberland turnpike road company, to be governed by the same regulations as are therein prescribed, and entitled to the same tolls, and every clause and provision in said acts relative to the road therein pro-
