

CHAP. 222. election, and to make such by laws as they shall deem necessary; and on the first Monday of January in every year, or within ten days thereafter, said company shall meet for the same purposes at such place as the president and managers shall appoint, and in all elections by stockholders each share shall be entitled to one vote, but no person or company shall have more than ten votes.

Stockholders incorporated

4. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the stockholders in said company shall be and they are hereby created and erected into a body politic and corporate, by the name and style of The Rock Run and Brick Meeting-House Turnpike Company, and by the same name shall have perpetual succession, and all the privileges and franchises incident to a corporation, and shall be capable of suing and being sued, answering and being answered, and of enlarging the stock by new subscriptions if the same shall be found necessary.

Payments

5. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the sums so subscribed shall be paid to the president and managers aforesaid in such sums, and at such times, as they may appoint, giving two months public notice of the payment so required.

Commissioners to be appointed to lay out road

6. **AND BE IT ENACTED.** That the president and managers be and they are hereby authorised to appoint five commissioners, who, or a majority of whom agreeing, shall lay out the road from the site of the Susquehanna Bridge, in Cecil county aforesaid, to the mouth of Rock Run, from thence to a site eight perches south of the Brick Meeting-House, thence till it intersects the Wilmington and Newark turnpike road, on as straight a line between each of said places as the nature of the ground and other circumstances will admit of, having regard to hills and other obstructions; and after having laid out and marked said road, they shall make one plot of the same, specifying the courses and distances, and return the same to the clerk of Cecil county court to be recorded; and the said commissioners, before they proceed to act, shall take the following oath, or affirmation: "I, A. B. do swear, (or affirm) that I will lay out and mark the Rock Run and Brick Meeting-House Turnpike Road according to the best of my skill and judgment, and according to the directions of an act of assembly, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the site of the Susquehanna Bridge in Cecil county, to Rock Run, from thence to a site eight perches south of the Brick Meeting-House, and from thence until it intersects the Wilmington and Newark turnpike road; and I do further swear, (or affirm) that I am not interested in any land through which said road is likely to pass."

Width of Road

7. **AND BE IT ENACTED,** That the said company shall open said road from the site of the Susquehanna Bridge to Rock Run, from thence to the Brick Meeting-House, and from thence till it intersects the Wilmington and Newark turnpike road, according to the location of the commissioners aforesaid, sixty feet wide, of which at least twenty feet shall be an artificial road, composed of stone, gravel, or other hard substance, and erect and keep up bridges over the streams crossing the same; and whenever two miles of said road shall be perfected, said company shall be entitled to receive tolls; *Provided,* that said company shall not be entitled to tolls after the year 1830, unless said twenty feet of width shall be composed of stone, gravel, or other hard substances; *Provided,* that no tolls shall be demanded or taken from any person passing or repassing from
