CHAP. XLII.

An Act to confirm an act, entitled, An act to repeal all that part of the Constitution and Form of Government as relates to the division of Dorchester County into three separate Election Districts. Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 528. Passed Jan 17 1818

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act passed at December session eighteen hundred and sixteen, entitled, An act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Dorchester county into three separate election districts, be and the same is hereby confirmed. CHAP. XLIII.

An Act for the support of Evan Price, of Montgomery County. Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 529. Passed Jan. 16 1818

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Montgomery county shall be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at their levy court, annually, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, the sum of forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Evan Price, and that the same be collected annually by the collector of Montgomery county, and paid to the said Evan Price, or his order. Levy authorised
for his support.
