5. AND BE IT ENACTED. That it shall be the duty of the levy CHAP. 62. court to take bond from said collector, with sufficient security, in the name of the state of Maryland, for the collection and payment bond. to the commissioners aforesaid, or to their assignees, of the said sum of money, at the time at which the public levy of Washington county is by law directed to be collected and paid, and that the collector shall be allowed the same as is allowed by law for collecting the county levy; and in case the said bond shall be forfeited, it shall and may be lawful for the levy court of said county, and they are hereby directed and required, to order suit or suits to be instituted against the said collector, and his securities, or either of them, for the purpose of enforcing the said collection agreeably to the provisions of this act.

6. And he it enacted, That the said commissioners, or a ma- commissioners and the said to borrow jority of them, shall be, and they are hereby empowered to borrow, money, from time to time, such sum or sums of money as they may conceive necessary, at an interest not exceeding six per centum per annum which said loan or coans shall be appropriated and applied by them to the purchase of the site, and to the erecting of the said gaol; and to ensure the repayment of the said sum or sums of money, with the interest thereon, the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall be and they are hereby authorised, to assign and transfer to the lender or lenders thereof, any part or parts of the before mentioned assessments, to be annually collected as aforesaid, which lender or lenders shall in such case have all the rights and privileges in enforcing the payment to them of the said assessments that the commissioners would have had if such transfer had not been made.

7. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the commissioners aforesaid shall Accounts to be annually render to the levy court of Washington county a particular court. account of the receipts and expenditures of all monies entrusted to them, and also the progress and state of the building until finally

That the commissioners aforesaid shall Meetings of commeet at the court ho se in Hager's-Town on the first Monday in April next, and may proceed to the discharge of the several duties provided by this act, and may adjourn from time to time as may be convenient and necessary, and each commissioner shall be entitled to receive two dollars for each day in which he may be engaged in the discharge of the duty haposed upon them by this act.
