CHAP. 70.

6. And he it enacted, That the subscribers aforesaid, and such as may according to the provisions herein after contained be-Bubicriber incor-come stockholders, and their successors, shall be, and they are hereby made and declared to be, a body politic and corporate, under the name of The President and Directors of the Patapsco Canal Company, and by that name shall be and are hereby made capable in law to have, purchase, receive, possess and enjoy, to them and their successors, lands, tenements, hereditaments, goods, chartels and effects, of waat kind, nature or quality soever, necessary for the accomplish nent of the objects contemplated by this act, and for no other purpose whatever, and the same to grant, demise, alien, convey and dispose of; to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, defend and be defended, in any court of record, or any place whatever, and also to make, have and use, a common scal, and the same to break, alter and renew, at pleasure; and also to ordain, establish, and put in execution, such by laws, ordinances and regulations, as shall seem necessary and convenient for the government of said corporation, and the management and conduct of their affairs, provided the same be not contrary to law and the constitution of this state.

Election of directors-their duties

7. And BE IT ENACTED, That the said commissioners shall give eight days notice in the public newspapers in the city of Baltimore, to the subscribers, to assemble at some place in the city of Baltimore, within twenty days after the subscription shall be closed as aforesaid, to elect twelve directors, which said directors shall, as soon after their election as may be, proceed to elect, either from among the stockholders, a fit and proper person to be president of the hoard of directors; which said president and directors shall be and are hereby authorised and empowered, to make all rules, regulations and by-laws, for the conduct and government of the corporation and its affairs; to create all such officers and agents of the corporation as they think right and proper for the management of its concerns; to prescribe their duties and compensation, and continuance in office, and also to employ labourers, workmen, and all others necessary for the objects of the corporation; and it shall be the duty of the president, in pursuance of the by-laws, rules and regulations, to superintend, direct and control, the officers and persons employed by the corporation, and from time to time, as required by the directors, to report the state, condition and progress, of the affairs of the corporation; but said president and directors shall be annually appointed in the manner herein before prescribed, on such days as shall be prescribed by the by-laws of the corporation; and if a director should be appointed president, or a director die, resign, or remove more than ten miles from the city of Baltimore, the president and directors shall have power to fill up the vacancy till a new election.

If whole amount is not subscribed, may again open

8. And BE IT ENACTED, That if the whole amount of stock herein authorised to be subscribed for shall not be taken at the time of closing the subscription by the commissioners as herein before provided for, the president and directors may, whenever and as often as they think proper, open the subscription, on twenty days notice in the newspapers of the city of Baltimore, for the purpose of taking additional subscriptions for such portion or the whole of the ansubscribed stock as they may think necessary for the objects to be effected by the corporation.
