aforesaid, not stamped as aforesaid directed, shall forfeit a sum CHAP. 156. not exceeding one hundred dollars; every penalty aforesaid to be recovered by indictment, or action of debt, in the county court of the county where the offence shall be committed, one half to the informer, and the other half to the use of the state.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That this act shall be in full force and commencement

effect from and after the first day of May next.

This act, so far as it imposes a tax, c. on the Bank of the United States, or the Branches thereof, was declared by the Supre le Court of the United States, at February Teras 1819, in the case of James W. M. Culloh against the state of Moryland, and John James, who as well &c. to be contrary to the constitution of the United States, and void. CHAP. CLVII.

A Supplement to an act*, entitled, An act to incorporate a Company Passed Feb 11, 1818 under the name of The Nottingham Library Company. Lib. TH.

No. 6, fol. 89.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Election of mana as soon as fifty shares of the capital stock of the said company shall be subscribed for, the commissioners named in the original act, or a majority of them, shall give notice thereof, by advertising according to the provisions of the original act, and appoint a day for the election of five managers and directors, which managers and directors shall be elected according to the provisions of the original act, in the same manner as if the whole capital stock of the said company had been subscribed for.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the fifty shares subscribed for Shares to be paid for before election previous to the election of the managers and directors, shall be

paid for according to the provisions of the original act.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the managers and directors shall subscriptions authorised to be rebe and are hereby authorised, to receive subscriptions for shares of ceived stock in the said company, at five dollars each, until the capital stock of the said company shall amount to two hundred shares, each share to be paid for in the following manner; that is to say, one half at the time of subscribing, the other half in three months thereafter.

CHAP, CLVIII.

An Act for the establishment of a Market for the Sale of Live Stock Passed Feb 11 1813 at the Rising Sun, in Cecil County. Lib. 1 H. No. 6, fol. 90.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Commissioners ap-Job Haines, Daniel Job, of Daniel, Benjamin Reynolds, James Jan-pointed ney, Henry Broughton, Thomas White, Francis Gellespie, James Eagan, Allen Kirk and Harlan Jones, or a majority of them. be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, with full power and authority, that from and after the first day of March next they are hereby authorised and empowered, to hold a market at the said place, on the first Thursday in June, August, September, October, November, January and March, in each and every year, at the said place, for the sale of live stock of every kind.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said commissioners, or a Commissioners majority of them, shall have full power to appoint a clerk and crier of the said market, and from time to time to make rules and ordinances, and by-laws, for the ordering and governing the said mar-
