## CHAP. CXCVIII.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Mary'and, That Acts continued all such acts, and parts of acts of assembly, as would expire with the present session, except an act, entitled, An act for the temporary relief of the poor in the several counties in this state, passed December session eighteen hundred and sixteen\*, be and the same . Ch. 192 are hereby continued until the twentieth day of November next. and until the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter.

## CHAP. CXCIX.

A Supplement to an Act, entitled. In Act relating to Coroners and Passed Feb 14 1818 Sheriffs, passed at November Session 1799, ch. 91. Lib. TH. No. 6. fol. 130.
