

CHAP. 211. are incident or necessary to such corporations, and what may be necessary to the corporation herein constituted, to enable them fully to execute all things concerning the design and intent of the said corporation, and to make such by-laws and regulations as they may find necessary for the government of said institutions, provided the same be not contrary to the laws of this state and of the United States.

Officers to be appointed to receive subscriptions.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said board of directors shall appoint such officers as in their discretion they may think advisable, whose duty it shall be to receive and take charge of all donations and subscriptions made to the dispensary, and to apply such funds, under the inspection of said board of directors, to furnishing medical aid to the patients contemplated to be benefitted by the same, and such other purposes as may be required.

CHAP. CCXII.

Passed Feb 15 1818 *An Act to pay the Civil List, and other expenses of Civil Government.* Lib. TH. No. 6, fol. 148.

Preamble

WHEREAS, those who dedicate their time, abilities and labour, to the public, ought to receive a reasonable compensation for their services;

Officers salaries

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following officers of the civil government, for the time being, shall be entitled to receive at the rate of the following salaries, in current money, for the ensuing year, to wit: The treasurer of the western shore, two thousand dollars; the treasurer of the eastern shore four hundred and fifty dollars; the auditor eight hundred dollars; the clerk of the council, one thousand dollars; the clerk of the senate one hundred and fifty dollars; the clerk of the house of delegates three hundred dollars; the printer to the state fourteen hundred dollars; the messenger to the council two hundred and fifty dollars.

Monies to be first applied to payment thereof.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED. That all monies which shall remain in the treasury after discharging the journal of accounts, and all unappropriated money which may come into the treasury, be first applied to the payment of the civil list for the ensuing year.

CHAP. CCXIII.

Passed Feb 16 1818 *An Act for the Payment of the Journal of Accounts.* Lib. TH. No. 6, fol. 149.

Preamble

WHEREAS, it appears by the journal of accounts of this session, that there is due from this state the sum of thirty-eight thousand eight hundred and fifteen dollars and thirty-seven and one-fourth cents, current money; therefore,

Treasurer authorised to pay

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore shall be and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay to the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or order, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of current money allowed to them respectively, as they may appear to be settled and ascertained by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now in the treasury, or that shall come into the treasury, subject to the appropriation of the general assembly.
