BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Caroline county, shall be, and they are hereby empowered, annually, if in their discretion they deem it right and proper, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said William Comegys, and his infant children, and that the same be collected annually by the collector of Caroline county, and by him paid to the said William Comegys, or to his order.
