

county, or be incapable to act, the levy court of said county shall fill up such vacancy. CHAP. 29.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners aforesaid shall meet at the court-house in Hager's-town, on the first Monday in March next, and may proceed to the discharge of the several duties provided by this act, and may adjourn from time to time, as may be convenient and necessary, and each commissioner shall be entitled to receive two dollars for each day in which he may be engaged in the discharge of the duty imposed upon them by this act. Commissioners to meet—their allowance

4. AND BE IT ENACTED, That when the new court-house at Hager's-town shall be completed, the said moderator and commissioners shall pull down the old court-house, and apply the materials of the same to the erection of the new market-house aforesaid, or sell the same at public sale to the highest bidder, under the express condition, that it shall be pulled down immediately; and the proceeds of the same shall be applied to discharge any debt contracted for building the market-house aforesaid. When new court-house is finished—old one to be sold.

5. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the moderator and commissioners of Hager's-town, be, and they are hereby authorised, to levy on the taxable property of Hager's-town, and its additions, such sum or sums of money as will, with the proceeds of the old court-house, be sufficient to pay for purchasing the site and erecting the market-house aforesaid, and shall collect the same, in two equal moieties, in the year eighteen hundred and nineteen and the year eighteen hundred and twenty. Levy authorised.

6. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the eighth section of the act, entitled, "An act to provide for the erection of a new court house in Hager's-town, Washington county," passed at December session eighteen hundred and fifteen*, be and the same is hereby repealed. Section repealed.

7. AND BE IT ENACTED, That before any property that may be condemned as aforesaid shall be taken possession of by the moderator and commissioners aforesaid, they shall pay or tender to the owner or owners of such property, the full amount of the valuation made as aforesaid. *Ch. 107
Before property condemned shall be taken possession of, amount of valuation to be paid

8. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the moderator and commissioners aforesaid shall have power to borrow such sum or sums of money as may be necessary to carry this act into effect, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per centum per annum. Commissioners authorised to borrow money

CHAP. XXIX.

An Act for the relief of Robert Atwell, of Anne-Arundel County. Lib. Passed Dec 23

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Anne-Arundel county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at their annual meeting, so long as they see cause so to do, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, the sum of thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Robert Atwell, and that the same be collected annually by the collector of Anne-Arundel county, and paid to the said Robert Atwell, or his order.
