BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Plate exempt from taxation all the plate which was presented to the late Colonel George Armistead, by a number of the citizens of Baltimore, as a testimonial of his services in the defence of that city, be and the same is hereby for ever hereafter exempted from all taxes, assessments, public dues, accuring to the state of Maryland, or to the county of Baltimore.
