A Supplement to an act\*, entitled. An act for the distribution of a Passed Jan 20 1815, ch 256. certain Fund for the purpose of establishing Free Schools in the several Counties therein named. Lib. TH No. 6, fol. 330.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Commissioners ap Thomas Turpin, Charles C. Brown, William Carmichael, William fund. R. Stewart, Daniel C. Hopper, Isaac Winchester, Walter K. White, James Roberts, James Brown, William Gilbert, Richard J. Harrison, and John Hackett, be and are hereby appointed a board of commissioners for the purpose of distribution and applying the fund mentioned in the act to which this is a supplement.
