

## CHAP. 159.

Passed Feb 11 1819

Act confirmed.

*An Act to confirm an act\*, entitled, An act to alter such parts of the Constitution and Form of Government as relate to appointments to Offices of Profit and Trust by the Governor and Council. Lib. TH. No. 6, fol. 373.*

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act, entitled, An act to alter such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to appointments to offices of profit and trust by the governor and council, passed at December session eighteen hundred and seventeen, be and the same is hereby confirmed.

## CHAP. CLIX.

## CHAP. CLX.

Passed Feb 11 1819

*An Act to authorise the Justices of the Levy Court of Dorchester County to levy a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned. Lib. TH. No. 6, fol. 373.*

Levy authorised for constructing a draw to Little Black Water Bridge.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Dorchester county, if in their opinion the public interest shall require it, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding sixty dollars, for the purpose of constructing a draw to the bridge commonly known by the name of Little Black Water River Bridge, in order to facilitate the navigation of said Black Water River.

## CHAP. CLXII.

*An Act Supplementary to the act† for the distribution of a certain Fund for the purpose of establishing Free Schools in the several Counties therein named. Lib. TH. No. 6, fol. 374.*

Commissioners for Dorchester county.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following persons shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners of the school fund for Dorchester county; Colonel Thomas Eunnalls, John Brohawn, John Willis, Doctor William Jackson, Robert Dennis, Richard Footell, Richard Pattison, Roger Woolford, Levin Lake, John Williams, William M. Robinson, Copewell Keenc, Joseph Byus, Edward Griffith, Richard Tubman, and George Lake; not less than six of whom shall be a quorum to do business.

Authorised to fill their own vacancies.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said commissioners shall have full power to fill up all vacancies that may occur in their body either by death or otherwise.
