To be returned <i>non est</i> from the county where a defendant resides, before he can be arrested by such <i>capias</i> out of his county, unless absconding—and the plaintiff otherwise to suffer a non suit, } A person arrested on attachment or <i>capias</i> , and permitted to go at large, may be again arrested in virtue of the same process, &c. CAPIAS AD SATISFA- CIENDUM.
