— May commit offenders for breaches of the peace, as justices might,	_____
— In case of death, resignation, &c. the levy courts to appoint others at any meeting thereafter,	_____
— The county clerks to record every appointment and make out warrants,	_____
— The warrants to be delivered within five days to the sheriffs, and by them, (within ten days,) to the persons appointed, or left at their last place of abode,	_____
— Penalty on the clerks or sheriffs neglecting the said duty,	_____
— Penalty on the judges not attending,	_____ 7
— In case neither of the judges attend for the space of one hour after the time directed, the justices of the county then present, or a majority authorised to choose three persons to be judges,	_____
— Or one justice, if only one is present,	_____
— If none present, the voters may choose three persons by ballot,	_____
— The persons chosen to be vested with the same powers as if chosen by the levy courts,	_____
— The judges to appoint two clerks above 21 years of age, to enter the names of the voters, who forfeit 10 dollars for neglect or refusal,	_____ 10
— Oath or affirmation to be taken by every judge and clerk, and a certificate thereof to be annexed to the polls,	_____ 11
— The election of electors of president and vice-president of the United States directed to be on the second Monday of November 1808, and on the same day in every fourth year thereafter,	_____ 9
— The election of representatives in Congress directed to be on the first Monday of October 1806, and on the same day in every second year thereafter,	_____
— The election of electors of the senate directed to be on the first Monday of September 1806, and on the same day in every fifth year thereafter,	_____
— The election of delegates to the general assembly directed to be on the first Monday of October, (then next,) and on the same day in every year thereafter,	_____
— The election of sheriffs directed to be on the first Monday of October 1806, and on the same day in every third year thereafter,	_____
— The elections directed to be held in the several districts, and at the several places established by the act of 1799, ch. 50, except where altered as therein stated,	_____
— The elections to commence at nine in the morning, and to continue without adjournment, and be closed at six in the evening of the same day,	_____ 12
— No ballot to be taken before the said hour of nine, nor after the said hour of six,	_____
— Every voter to deliver to the judges a ballot, on which shall be written or printed the names of the persons voted for, and the purpose for which the vote is given,	_____
— The ballots to be deposited in the box by the judges until the poll be closed,	_____
— Penalty on judges or others unfolding or opening them with design to discover the names,	_____
— Penalty on voters offering more than one ballot, with a fraudulent design,	_____
