LEVY COURTS.	The levy court for Baltimore county revived, A supplement to the act of 1794, ch. 53, directing accounts to be left by the collectors before distraining for the county tax, Returns to be made to the levy courts by the county clerks, of fines imposed on witnesses by justices of the peace, to be applied to the county charges, The levy courts directed to make reasonable compensation to commissioners for altering election districts in certain counties, to be levied, &c. as county charges, — Lists of fines under this act to be returned to them by the county clerks, &c. Bonds given by constables to be approved by the levy courts, Duties of the levy courts prescribed as to the nomination of inspectors of tobacco warehouses, &c.
