The levy courts shall annually cause their clerks to make out as many lists of the monies levied for county charges as there are election districts,	1802 81

— To be signed by the clerks, and delivered to the sheriffs ten days before the election for delegates, &c.	— — —
— To be set up by the sheriffs at each place of holding elections within six days after delivery,	— — —
