SALARIES. SALES.	On sales on execution against state debtors, or their securities, the governor and council to appoint a fit person to act for the state, &c. Sales for the payment of fines and costs, authorised under the act to prohibit the emigration of free negroes into this state, Directions for the sale of slaves and servants after confinement in the penitentiary, Provision for the sale of intestates real estates on awarding a part of the proceeds to the tenant by the curtesy, A sale to be ordered by the orphans courts, where an equal distribution of specific articles cannot be made, A sale authorised by <i>fiery facias</i> of equitable estates in lands, A sale to be made by the succeeding sheriff, &c in case of property taken, and the death of the sheriff, &c before a sale, Directions as to what shall be due and legal notice of sales on execution, &c.
