FREDERICK COUNTY.	Times of holding the county court altered, — A Supplement, Levy court authorised to levy for the payment of the costs accrued upon the trial of Thomas Burk in Washington county,
FREEMAN, NATHANIEL,	A trustee appointed for the sale of land which he died seised,
FREEMAN, SAMUEL,	The title to a tract of land purchased of him by John Cushwa, jr. made perfect,
