THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED:

CHAP. IV.

An act for the putting in force of some (a) Laws for the Government of the Province. Lib. C and WH. fol. 75.

Passed 23d of March 1641.

(a) *Viz.* Certain branches of 1638, ch. 2, hereby continued 'til the end of the next Assembly, &c. Expired.

CHAP. V.

An act for granting One Subsidy. Lib. C and WH. fol. 76. Expired. Ditto.

CHAP. VI.

An Act against Fugitives. Lib. C and WH. fol. 78.

Ditto.

This act was superseded by the act of 1649, ch. 5, which last was repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

The above laws were published, under the Great Seal, the 26th March 1642.

At a General Assembly, begun and held at St. Mary's on the 18th day of July 1642, in the 11th year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Cæcilus, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore, and ended the 1st day of August following, 1642.

THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED BY THE LORD PROPRIETARY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE FREEMEN:

CHAP. I.

Any Ten Members of the House, at any time assembled, at the usual or appointed Time (whereof the Licutenant General and Six Burgesses to be Seven) shall be a House, unless Sickness do hinder that Number: In which Case only the Members present to make the House. Lib. C and WH. fol. 79. Expired.
