### THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED:

#### CHAP. I.

An act for the settling the present House of Assembly. Expired. Passed Jan. 20th

#### CHAP. II.

An order of this present Assembly for the levying of Corn, towards Passed 24th January the defraying of the Soldiers Wages. Expired.

#### CRAP. III.

An act touching the Extent of Attachments and Executions. Passed 4th March Repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

#### CHAP. IV.

An act touching the Payment of Debts. Repealed by 1676, ch. 2. Diego.

#### CHAP. V.

An act touching Pagans.

Confirmed among the perpetual Laws by 1676, ch. 2, and Repealed 1678, ch. 16-

#### CHAP. VI.

An act for settling Government in the Province, as the present Ditto.

State of Things will permit.

Certain parts of this act were dissented from by the Proprietary, and other parts repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

The acts of this Assembly do not appear to be recorded.

Acts and Orders of Assembly, assented to, enacted and made, at a General Session of the said Assembly, begun and held at St. Mary's on the 2d day of April 1649, and ended the 21st day of the same month,
