For 3 years, &c. Continued by the several reviving acts, till its expiration in 1692.

## CHAP. VIII.

Ditto. An act for Military Discipline.

For 3 years, &c. Continued under various reviving acts, till its repeal by 1676, ch. 2.

## CHAP. IX.

Ditto. An Explanation of that Clause of an † Act, made by Capt. William Stone, the 29th April 1650, concerning the Secretary's and Sheriff's Fees. Repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

## CHAP. X.

Ditto. An act limiting Servants Times.

For 3 years, &c. An explanatory act, 1662, ch. 6. and a new act 1662, ch. 20. Expired.

## CHAP. XI.

Ditto. An act concerning the Killing wild Cattle. Repealed by 1663-4, ch. 3. and 1678, ch. 16.

## CHAP. XII.

Ditto. An act empowering the Governor and Council, to raise Forces, and maintain a War, without the Province, and to aid the Susquehannah Indians.

For 2 years, or to the end of the next general assembly. Expired.

## CHAP. XIII.

Ditto. An act for the reviving of certain Laws, within this Province.

Viz. 1658, ch. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, hereby continued 3 years &c. Expired.

## CHAP. XIV.

Ditto. An act for Support of Government.

Viz. 12lb of casked tobacco, to his Lordship, and his heirs, for every taxable, for 3 years. Expired.

## CHAP. XV.

Ditto. An act for levying Eighteen Pounds of Tobacco per Poll raised the last Year. Expired.
