CHAP. I.

An act prohibiting Trade with the Indians, for any Flesh dead or ^{Passed May 1,}
alive, except Deer or Wild Fowl. Lib. C and WH. fol. 154. ^{1666.}

For 3 years, &c. Continued by several Reviving acts. Expired. A new law
made 1692, ch. 33.

CHAP. II.

An act for appointing Coroners in each respective County. Lib. ^{Ditto}
C and WH. fol. 155. Lib. WH. fol. 143. and Lib. WH and L.
fol. 29.

Confirmed 1676, ch. 2. Repealed. A new act made 1692, ch. 56.

CHAP. III.

An act for Confirmation of the Articles of Peace made with the ^{Ditto}
Indians. Lib. C and WH. fol. 155. Lib. WH. fol. 143. and
Lib. WH and L. fol. 30.

Confirmed 1676, ch. 2.

CHAP. IV.

An act prohibiting foreign Ingrossers. Lib. C and WH. fol. 156. ^{Ditto}
Lib. WH. fol. 158. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 30.

For 3 years, &c. Was repealed by 1676, ch. 2, revived again by 1678, ch. 15,
and thence continued by several reviving acts, till 1692, when a new act was
made, ch. 77.

CHAP. V.

An act prohibiting Commissioners, Sheriffs and Clerks, to plead ^{Ditto}
as Attorneys in their respective County Courts. Lib. C and
WH. fol. 156. Lib. WH. fol. 157. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 31.

Confirmed 1676, ch. 2. Repealed. A new law 1671, ch. 13.

CHAP. VI.

An act prohibiting the Office of Clerks and Sheriffs to be officiated ^{Ditto}
at the same Time, by one and the same Person. Lib. C and
WH. fol. 157. Lib. WH. fol. 144. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 31.

Confirmed 1676, ch. 2. Repealed.
