An act for the Encouragement of the sowing and making of Hemp ^{Ditto} and Flax. Repealed by 1676, ch. 2.

CHAP. XXI.

An act for the Enrolment of Conveyances, and securing the Estates ^{Ditto} of Purchasers.

CHAP. XXII.

An act for the payment of the public charge of this province. Re- ^{Ditto} pealed by 1676, ch. 2.
