Passed 15th Nov.
1678

An act for Pnishment of Edward Husbands, for Menacing and Cursing this Assembly, &c. Lib. C and WH. fol. 365. Lib. WH. fol. 238. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 181. Obsolete.

Memorandum. His Lordship's proclamation of dissent to all and every act and acts of Assembly, made in this year, such only excepted as his Lordship (since his arrival here) by his assent in a general assembly, had continued, confirmed, or revived, which are also to stand continued or revived to all intents, &c. is dated the 5th May 1684. CHAP. I.

Passed 17th Sept.
1681

An act for the ordering and regulating the Militia of this Province, for the better security and Defence thereof. Lib. WH. fol. 160.

CHAP. II.

Ditto

An act for the better Administration of Justice, in Probat's of Wills, Granting Administrations, Recovery of Legacies, and securing Filial Portions. Lib. WH. fol. 167.

To be in force 3 years, &c. Continued 1682, ch. 8 and 12. 1684, ch. 6. 1686, ch. 3, and 1688, ch. 2. A new Law 1692, ch. 3.

CHAP. III.

Ditto

An act for more speedy bringing to trial, and suppressing Criminals, and limiting their punishments for certain Offences, when prosecuted in the County Courts. Lib. WH. fol. 172.

To be in force 3 years, &c. Continued 1682, ch. 8 and 12. 1684, ch. 6. 1686, ch. 3. and 1688, ch. 2. A new Law 1692, ch. 34.

CHAP. IV.

Ditto

An act concerning Negroes and Slaves. Lib. WH. fol. 174.

This act repeals 1663-4, ch. 6. A new law 1692, ch. 79.

CHAP. V.

Ditto

An act for preventing vexatious and unnecessary Suits at Law. Lib. WH. fol. 175.

To be in force 3 years, &c. Continued 1682, ch. 8 and 12. 1684, ch. 6. 1686, ch. 3. and 1688, ch. 2. A new law 1692, ch. 67.

CHAP. VI.

Ditto

An act restraining the exportation of leather and raw Hides, Deer and Elk Skins, out of this Province, for the encouragement of Tanners and Shoemakers. Lib. WH. fol. 176.
