

APPENDIX.—RESOLUTIONS.

Nov. Sess.  
1797.

No. 19.

**RESOLVED**, That Rufus King do not accept, on the part of this state, the transfer of said stock, if the release or dereliction of the state's right to any part be insisted on as a condition precedent to the transfer of the residue.

Not to receive transfer if release of state's right to any part be insisted on.

No. 20.

**RESOLVED**, That Rufus King be authorised and requested to transfer to the order of Samuel Chase four per cent. in bank stock on the amount that may be transferred to him for the use of this state.

Authorised to transfer S. Chase four per cent. on the amount transferred to him.

No. 21.

**RESOLVED**, That Samuel Chase, agent of this state, be requested to transmit duplicate copies of these resolutions, as speedily as possible, to Rufus King, through the secretary of the United States.

No. 22.

WHEREAS a resolution passed on the twenty-sixth December last, empowering those who were in possession of warrants or surveys made in Allegany county to compound, by giving bond in three equal annual payments for the composition that might be due thereon, when no return of the survey had been made to the land-office; and it appearing reasonable that indulgence should also be granted to those who have been careful and active in having their surveys completed and returned to the land office, agreeably to the directions of the act of November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-five, therefore, **RESOLVED**, That all those who have had their surveys made in Allegany county, and have had the same passed by the examiner-general, and filed in the land office, agreeably to the directions of the before cited act, shall have the privilege of installing at any time before the first day of June next, by giving bond, with such security as the western shore treasurer shall require, for payment of the principal sum due in three equal annual instalments, and interest thereon from the date of the bond; and if payment shall not be made according to the times aforesaid, process of seire facias shall issue upon the said bonds for the immediate recovery of the sum of money due against the persons, their lands and chattels, of the several obligors therein mentioned, and the lands affected by such surveys shall be bound for the payment of the composition due.

No. 23.

**RESOLVED**, That six hundred dollars be advanced by the treasurer of the western shore, on or before the first day of August next, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, to the order of the president and trustees of Charlotte Hall school, in Saint-Mary's county, provided it shall appear to the governor that there are in the said academy thirty standing students.

**RESOLVED**, That the committee of claims be authorised and directed, and they are hereby authorised and directed, to examine and burn the sum of eight thousand eight hundred and fifty pounds of the emissions made in pursuance of an act of congress of the
