RESOLVED. RESOLVED, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he Passed Feb 7, 1818 is hereby directed to pay to John Robbins, an old soldier, of Mont-bins gomery county, a sum of money annually, in quarterly payments, equal to the half pay of a private, as a further compensation for his revolutionary services.

No. 17.

RESOLVED, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is Passed Feb 7, 1878 hereby authorised, to pay to Robert Bruce, of Charles county, or Bruce his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a trooper, instead of the half pay of a common soldier in the line, as was allowed him by the last legislature, and that the treasurer be also authorised to pay to him, or his order, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a trooper for fifteen months.

RESOLVED, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he Passed Febr., this is hereby directed, to pay to James Leonard, of Cecil county, an nard old soldier, or his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, as a further remuneration for his services during the revolutionary war.
