No. 19.

Passed Feb 7, 1818  
— in favour of Ig-  
natius Brashears

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Ignatius Brashears, of Prince-George's county, an old soldier, annually, in quarterly payments, during life, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, as a further compensation for his services during the revolutionary war.

Passed Feb 7, 1818  
— of Robert Hal-  
kerson

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay unto Robert Halkerson, of Charles county, an old revolutionary officer, in quarterly payments, the half pay of a lieutenant for life, instead of the sum allowed him by a resolution passed January the sixth eighteen hundred and twelve.

No. 21.

Passed Feb 7, 1818  
— of Joseph Ray

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby directed to pay unto Joseph Ray, an old soldier, of Montgomery county, or to his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, for his services during the revolutionary war.

No. 22.

Passed Feb 7, 1818  
— of Nathaniel  
Downing

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby required and directed, to pay annually to Nathaniel Downing, or his order, of Prince-George's county, an old revolutionary soldier, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private soldier, as a further remuneration to the said Nathaniel Downing for the services rendered his country in that war.

— of John C.

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore, be and he is hereby directed to pay to John Codiep Hanspan, of Anne-Arundel county, an old soldier, or his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private.

Passed Feb 7, 1818  
— of John New-  
ton

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby authorised, to pay to John Newton, an old soldier, or his order, during his life, a sum of money annually, in half yearly payments, equal to the half pay of a private, for his services during the revolution.

Passed Feb 7 1818  
— of John Shotts

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby authorised and directed, to pay to John Shotts, of Frederick county, an old soldier, or to his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, during his life.

Passed Feb 7 1818  
— of Tobias Rey-  
nolds

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby directed, to pay to Tobias Reynolds, of Anne-Arundel county, an old soldier, or to his order, annually, in quarterly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private.

Passed Feb 10 1818  
— of George  
Montle

**RESOLVED**, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby directed, to pay to George Montle, or Mondle, now of the state of Pennsylvania, and late a soldier in the Maryland line, during the revolutionary war, or his order, a sum of money annually, in quarterly payments, equal to the half pay of a soldier, as
