

APPENDIX. — CHANCERY LAWS.

CHAP. 30.

And allow a commission to trustees, &c.

5. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the chancellor shall have full power and authority to allow any guardians, trustees, agents or factors, who shall make disposition or sale of either real, personal or mixed property, for the purpose of paying the debts of deceased persons or others, under and in virtue of any order or decree of the chancery court, a commission from one *per cent.* to seven and an half *per cent.* for their trouble in selling and disposing thereof, and paying the same away in pursuance of such order or decree, as the chancellor shall, on consideration of all circumstances, think just and right.

Preamble

WHEREAS by an act, entitled, An act for enlarging the powers of the high court of chancery, passed at a session of the general assembly of Maryland begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Monday the seventh day of November, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, full power and authority is given to the chancellor to direct the sale of all lands in this state held by minors, residents of this state; and it appearing reasonable and right that lands, lying in this state, belonging to minors, residents of any other state, should be subject to sale, for the payment of the debts due from the deceased person, in the same manner as the lands belonging to citizens of this state;

Chancellor to direct the sale of lands, &c.

2. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the chancellor shall have the same power to direct the sale of lands, lying within this state, belonging to minors, residents of any other state, for the payments of debts due from the deceased, as he hath in case of minors, residents of this state.

Notice to be given &c.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the petitioner or petitioners to the chancellor for the sale of the lands as aforesaid, to give such notice to the guardian or guardians of minors, nonresidents of this state, in such manner as the chancellor shall direct.
