

CHAP. 61. **circumstances of the said John Randle, Ally Campbell and Rebecca Dennis, are such as to render a situation in the poor-house particularly unsuitable for them, to support them as out pensioners, in addition to the number now allowed by the act, (a) entitled, An act to enlarge the powers of the trustees of the poor in the several counties therein designated, and to allow to the said John Randle, Ally Campbell and Rebecca Dennis, not exceeding thirty dollars each, to be paid at such time as the said trustees shall direct, the amount of which said pensions shall be levied in the same manner as the other expenses of the poor-house in the said county; *Provided*, that the application of the said John Randle, Ally Campbell and Rebecca Dennis, to be supported as out pensioners as aforesaid, shall be recommended by the levy court of said county.**

CHAP. LXII.

\* 1803, ch. 66. **A Supplement to the act,\* entitled, An act to straighten part of the Road in Harford County which leads from Underhill's Mill to the City of Baltimore. Lib. TH. No. 1, fol. 64.**

*Preamble.*

WHEREAS sundry inhabitants of Harford county, by their petition have represented to this general assembly, that the commissioners appointed under the original act to which this is a supplement, in taking a view of ground over which the road in the said original act mentioned was contemplated to pass, that it would be more advantageously laid out, to intersect at the Rock Ford, on the Little Falls, instead of intersecting at Hanway's mill, as provided in the said original act, and praying that an act may pass appointing commissioners to make the alterations aforesaid on said road, beginning near a place called and known by the name of The Sandy Bottom, on the road leading from Coop's-town to Hanway's mill, and to straighten and amend the said road until they intersect the Rock Ford, on the Little Falls, with power to assess the damages; and the same being considered reasonable, therefore,

*Commissioners appointed to review road.*

2. **BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William Welch, Benjamin Quinland and Benjamin Rigdon, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and empowered to review the said road leading from Underhill's mill to Baltimore, beginning near a place called The Sandy Bottom, on the road leading from Coop's-town to Hanway's mill, and to straighten the same in such manner, and in such places, until it intersects the Little Falls of Gunpowder at the Rock Ford, as in their judgment will best comport with public convenience, so as the same shall not be straightened to run through the yard, orchard or garden, of any person, without the consent of the owner or owners thereof; and the said commissioners are hereby directed to return a plot of said road, so straightened, to the clerk's office of said county, to be there filed and recorded; *Provided always*, that the levy court for said county, for sufficient cause, may reject said plot and return, and may direct the said commissioners to return another plot thereof, and so from time to time, till a plot shall be returned which shall be approved of and confirmed by said levy court.**

3. **AND BE IT ENACTED, That the levy court of said county, if a plot shall be returned, approved of and confirmed as aforesaid, be and it is hereby empowered, at the next court thereafter, to ap-**
