WHEREAS it has been represented to this general assembly, by Preambled the petition of sundry inhabitants of Harford county, that they labour under great inconvenience from the want of a public road leading from William Pyles's saw mill, on Deer creek, to intersect award leading from William Clark's ford, on said creek, to Belle-Air, at or near the form of Aquila Grafion, stating in their petition, that no charge should be made for the land over which the road may be hid; and the same being reasonable, therefore,

BR IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Commissioner William Clarke, William Welsh and John Pyles, be and they are out a road. hereby appointed commissioners, and they, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and empowered to lay out, survey, mark and bound, a road in said county, from William Pyles's saw mill, on Deer creek, to intersect a road leading from William Clark's ford, \* ea said creek, to Belle-Air, at or near the farm of Aquila Grafton, in such direction as the nature of the ground and the convenience of the landholders over which the same may run will admits Provi- Provise which that the said road shall not be laid out through the lands of any individual without his, her or their consent in writing first had and obtained; and a plot of said road, when surveyed and laid out, stogether with a certificate of the courses of the same, shall be re-
