Se And BERT SHASTED, That the respective sheriffs abalt, un-bally below to be a second der the penalty of five hundred dellars, provide, or course to be provided, and delivered to the judge or judges of the election in each district, previous to, or at the commencement of, each election, a box for receiving the ballots, and two separate books, for the purpose of entering the voters names.

6. And BE IT SNAOTER, That the justices of the levy courts point judge d respectively shall between the first Monday of April and the first elections. Monday of August next, appoint three persons for each election district, resident therein, who, or a majority or any one of whom, in case of the nonattendance of the other two, shall be judges or judge of the election for such district, from the time of their appointment until a new appointment; and the said court shall, every year thereafter, between the first Monday of April and the first Monday of Angust (a), appoint judges as aforesaid in each election district, for holding elections therein until displaced by a new appointments and the said judges, or such of them as shall attents shall be conservators of the peace during the continuance of the election (b), and until the ballots shall be counted, and the necessamy certificates required by this act shall be made out and subscribth by the said judges and clerks, and shall be vested, and hereby are vested, with the power and authority to commit offenders for any breach of the peace, in like manner as any justice of the peace for such county; and in case any of the said judges shall die, resign, rouge out of the district, or become otherwise, in the opinion of the court, disqualified to act as judge, the said court shall, at any meeting thereafter, appoint a person as judge in his places and at every appointment of judge or judges as aferesaid, the clerk of the county court shall record the same, and make out a warrant therefer; and the clerk shall, within five days thereafter, deliver every such warrant to the sheriff of the county, and it shall be the duty of the shoriff, within ten days after receiving the same, to do. liver the same to the person or persons so appointed, or leave it at his or their last place of abode, under the penalty of fifty dollars on the clerk or sheriff respectively who shall neglect his duty

(2) By 1807, ch. 28, the levy court of Saint Mary's county shall, some time in the month of August, annually, appoint judges of elections for each election dis-

trick in the county. (b) By November 1812, ch. 19, the judges of election in each election district in Scilonunty, shall appoint two constables of their respective districts, to attend

on the days of election, for the preservation of peace, &c.

7. AND BE IT ENACTED, That any judge so appointed, who shall Penalty on judges not attend at the time appointed for holding any election in his district, shall forfeit fifty dollars for every such neglect, unless prevented by sickness, or other sufficient cause in the opinion of the court and jury before whom the prosecution therefor shall be heard, tried and determined.

8. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case neither of the judges are absent, how afteresaid shall attend as aforesaid for the space of one hour after others are to be appointed. the time herein directed for opening the election, it shall and may be lawful for the justices of the peace for the said county then present at said place of election, or the majority of them, or for one instice of the peace, in the event of but one being present, or in
