CHAP. CXXVII.

An Act for the relief of Benjamin Morris, of Baltimore County. Lib. TH. No. 1, fol. 441. Passed Jan 20 1808

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the judges of Baltimore county court be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to extend to the said Benjamin Morris, the full benefit and relief of the act of assembly passed at November session, eighteen hundred and five,* entitled, An act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors, and the supplement thereto, passed at November session, eighteen hundred and six,† without compelling the said Benjamin Morris to produce any evidence of his having resided in the state of Maryland for two years last previous to his application for the benefit thereof, agreeable to the provisions of the said act, and supplement thereto.

CHAP. CXXVIII.

CHAP. CXXIX.

An Act investing the Justices of the Levy Courts of the several Counties in this State with further powers. Lib. TH. No. 1, fol. 464. Passed Jan 20 1808. See 1800, ch. 85, and Nov. 1812, ch. 191.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by sundry inhabitants of the state, that errors have been committed by assessors, in consequence whereof many citizens have been compelled to pay twice on the same property; therefore,

Preamble.

2. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall and may be lawful for the levy courts in the several counties of this state, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, when they shall be satisfied that any error has arisen by assessing property not liable to be assessed by any assessor, or in any other way, to rectify such errors, and to levy and assess, in the same manner as other county charges, any sum of money which any person may have been charged with and paid in consequence of any such error, and to pay the said sum of money, so assessed, to the person, or his order, for whom the same was levied.

Levy courts authorised, when satisfied that any error has arisen by assessing property, to correct such error.

CHAP. CXXX.

A Further Additional Supplement to the act,† entitled, An act to incorporate Companies to make several Turnpike Roads through Baltimore County, and for other purposes. Lib. TH. No. 1, fol. 464. Passed Jan 20 1808. 1804, ch. 51.
