quish, without any consideration therefor, all claim and title to the CHAP 143, same, to the city of Baltimore, and the same shall for ever thereafter be deemed and taken as a public street or highway.

CHAP. CXLIV.

A Further Supplement to the act*, entitled, An act to incorporate Passed Jan 20 1803. Companies to make several Turnpike Roads through Baltimore County, and for other purposes. Lib. TH. No. 1, fol. 481.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that in Preamble. pursuance of the powers vested in the commissioners of the Baltimore and York-town turnpike road, by the act to which this is a further supplement, that they have opened subscription books, and there has been subscribed the amount of the capital stock authorised by said act on said road, and they have petitioned that they may be permitted immediately to commence turnpiking the same; and this assembly being of opinion that their prayer is reasonable, therefore.
