and in case the said commissioners shall confirm the said road, then and in that case they shall proceed to assess such further damages as they in their judgment shall think the landholders over which the said road is laid entitled to, in addition to the sum or sums of money already levied for them; and the said commissioners shall return to the clerk's office of Harford county a full and correct statement of their proceeding, either in case of their rejecting or confirming the said road, to be there recorded.

3. And BE IT ENACTED, That the levy court shall, in case the If further damage of the per associated court said road be confirmed as aforesaid, and further damages assessed to levy the same, by the said commissioners, levy, and direct the same to be point. by the said commissioners, levy, and direct the same to be paid over to such person or persons as shall be entitled thereto; and in case the said commissioners shall reject the aforesaid road, then and in that case the sum or sums of money already levied for the purpose of satisfying the damages sustained by the landholders over which the said road is laid, shall be under the control and direction of the levy court, and by them applied towards defraying the county charges.

4. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the aforesaid commissioners, or Commissioners a majority of them, in case they shall not reject the said road al-on of road. together, shall have power to alter the location thereof, if they in their judgment shall deem the same necessary, and in such case a survey and plot thereof cause to be made and returned to the clerk's office of said county, there to be recorded.

5. And BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners of review, Their allowance. hereby appointed, shall have an allowance of two dollars for each and every day they shall attend in discharge of their duties herein imposed.

6. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the said commissioners, or a If they determine road shall not be majority of them, shall determine that the said road should not be opened, to inquire opened, they are hereby directed to inquire if any, and if any, been paid for dawhat sum or sums of money has been paid to the persons over mages, &c. whose land the said road has passed, as a compensation for the damages, which if it had been opened they would have sustained, and whether the sum or sums so paid is more than a just compensation, and how much more than a just compensation it may be, and to make a return thereof to the levy court of Harford county, who are hereby authorised, empowered and directed, to appoint a suitable person to call upon the landholders aforesaid, for the payment of such surplus sum or sums paid to them as may be returned by the said commissioners, and if the said landholders shall neglect to pay, or cause to be paid, within six months thereafter, to such person appointed as aforesaid, the sum or sums returned to be due, the levy court aforesaid are directed either to sue or warrant for the same, as may seem to them to be proper and legal.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Levy authorised for their support. the levy court of Anne-Arundel county be and they are hereby authorised, so long as they shall see cause, to assess and levy on the
