## STATUTES

Made at WESTMINSTER, Anno 4 HEN. IV. and A. D. 1402.

### CAP. V.

Every Sheriff shall in Person continue in his Bailiwick, and shall not let it.

*Item* it is ordained and assented, That every Sheriff of *England* shall abide in proper Person within his Bailiwick, for the time that he shall be such Officer; (2) and that he shall not let the said Bailiwick to farm to any Man for the time that he occupieth such Office.
