Stated terms.

Section 1. The stated terms of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, of the Court of Common Pleas in the City of Baltimore, Baltimore City Court and the Criminal Court of Baltimore, shall commence on the second Monday of January; the second Monday in May, and the second Monday in September in each year.

Return days.

Section 2. In addition to the first day of each term of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, the Court of Common Pleas, and Baltimore City Court, the second Monday in February, March, April, June, July, October, November and December in each year shall be return days.

In force.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
